Certain behaviors will not be tolerated. Individuals who violate the ADM Board's policies for social media best use may be blocked from engaging with any and/or all of the ADM Board's accounts.

The ADM Board reserves the right to remove submissions that contain vulgar language, personal attacks of any kind, or offensive comments that target or disparage any ethnic, racial, religious, or any other group or individual.

Further, the ADM Board reserves the right to remove comments that violate our best practices, including, but not limited to, those that are:

- Spam or anything that includes links to other sites that do not meet the ADM Board's standards
- Off topic
- Advocating illegal or harmful activity
- Promoting services, products, or political organizations
- An infringement of copyrights or trademarks
- Providing personally identifiable medical information
- Discussing case-specific or confidential information
