


## **CAP Review**

- Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 340.03
  - Boards are required to plan and evaluate publicly-funded behavioral health services and to submit a plan for approval to OhioMHAS
- In 2022, the state revised the Community Assessment
  - 3-year plan
  - Uniformity across the state
  - An assessment phase was added
  - Focus on reporting
  - Annual reporting
    - 2024 → Progress on 8 of 9 Goals
