What is Recovery Housing?

Definition Per Ohio Recovery Housing (ORH)

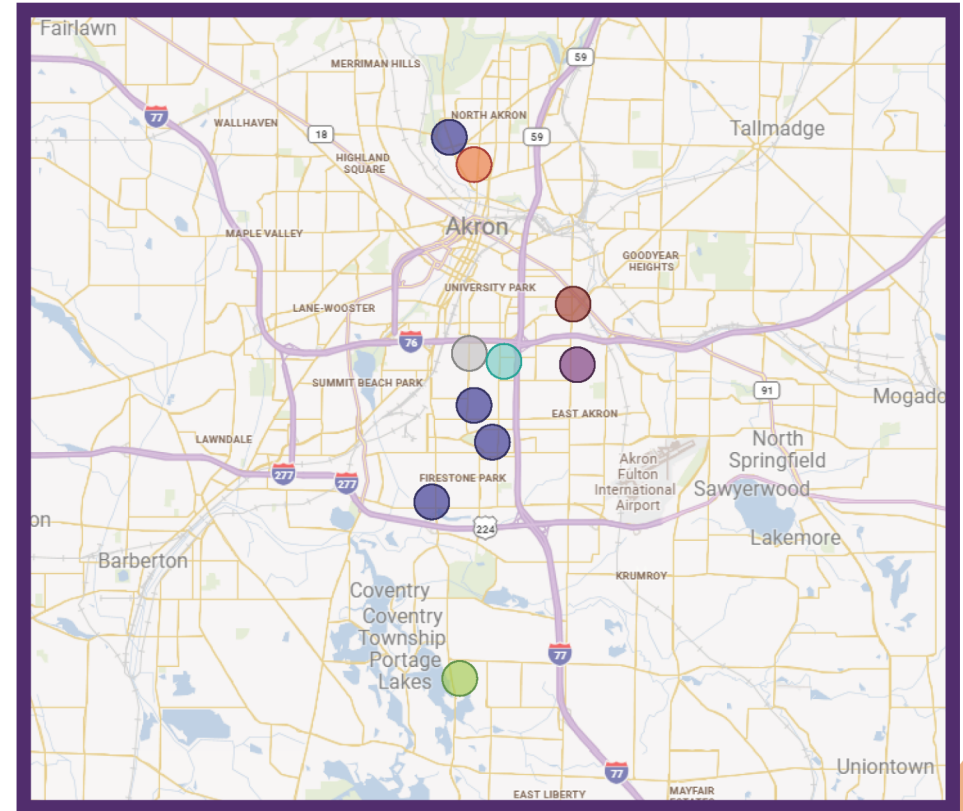
- Housing for individuals recovering from drug addiction that provides an alcohol- and drug-free living environment, peer support, assistance with obtaining addiction services, and other addiction recovery assistance.
- The National Alliance of Recovery Residences defines recovery housing as sober, safe, and healthy living environments dedicated to promoting recovery from alcohol, drugs, and other associated problems.

ADM Board-Funded Houses

- ORH Certified
- Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) supported
- Curfews enforced
- Random drug screenings
- Must complete pre-admission interview and application

Things to Know

- Must be a Summit County resident to qualify.
- Some sobriety time may be required, depending upon the level of the house.
- Most programs offer peer support services, housing amenities, furnished rooms, case management, and other supportive services.
- The County of Summit ADM funds all levels of recovery housing.

Program Highlights

- Offers employment training and a readiness program

Recovery Housing Levels

Level 1

- Six months or greater in sustained abstinence from drugs and alcohol
- Peer-run, decision made solely by residents
- Recovery-supportive culture and community using house rules and peer accountability

Level 2

- Seven days or greater in sustained abstinence from drugs and alcohol
- Managed environment with house rules and appointed resident leader
- Some Level 2s provide recovery support services and life skills development at a lower intensity than Level 3s

Level 3

- No sustained abstinence from drugs and alcohol needed for admission
- Allows supervised activities, staffing, and life skills programming
