## **III. Unfinished Business**

#### C. Update on Recreational Marijuana Legislation

- Dr. Doug Smith, Chief Clinical Officer discussed the recreational marijuana legislation updates and the status of rescheduling marijuana from a Schedule I to Schedule III drug.
- A Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) hearing on the proposed rescheduling of marijuana on January 21, 2025 has been postponed, which has delayed the process for approximately 3 months.
- Ohio companies are concerned as sales in the first 4 months lagged behind some other states in the first 4 months.
- Calls to Ohio poison control centers increased by 25% between 2023 and 2024 for adults and youth.
- In the Youth Risk Behavior Survey, middle and high school trends for students ever trying Marijuana has decreased from 2013, 2018, and 2023.
- Senate Bill 56, introduced by Senator Steve Huffman, is proposing a law change to increase tax from 10% to 15%. The introduced budge, HB96, proposes and increases to 20%, with a breakdown of various allocations for officer-related training, jails, substance use prevention, treatment, recovery programs, and 988.

## **IV. New Business**

#### D. Update on 2023 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS)

- Kimberly Patton, Associate Director of Clinical Services provided an overview of the YRBS results specific to mental health and suicide behaviors.
- Based on local data the ADM Board collects, the youth suicide rate in Summit County has decreased. In 2024 there were 3 deaths by suicide from ages 0-14 and 1 death by suicide from ages 15-19.
- Associate Director Patton then gave an overview on the county-wide statistics of the following questions based on the YRBS data: Felt sad or hopeless, Hurt themselves without wanting to die, Seriously considered suicide, Made a plan about how they would attempt suicide, Attempted suicide, and Received help when sad, empty, hopeless or anxious.
- ADM has multiple providers in our system that provide in and out of school services using evidence based practices for suicide prevention. As follow-up to the YRBS data results there will be additional funding opportunities targeting risk and protective factors that impact areas resiliency and wellbeing.
